Dear Dr. Richmond:

I have not news from Dave since his last latter in April 13, Mr. Dean has written to Emilio and past days arrived a telegram announcing the arrival of several boxes.

I thank very much your concern in sending all the equipmer and also I am wishing to have it here to speed our works, because the Packard analyzers are many times out of work. The technical people of Packard is very lazy and we are awaiting several weeks for one of them who has to come in order to repair both sets. I think that when all items be working we will be able to increase our data.

As I told Dave this Junta has been reorganized and our old Division has been divided. Part of it has been integrated with some safety people and general labour matters as a Section depending of the General Secretary. I concern only with the problem of the Center. Another people of the old División has been trasfered to a new "Protection and Nuclear Safety División" linked to the General Director and devoted to outer problems such as nuclear power reactors, radioactive installations, transport, licensing etc. Emilio and another physicist has been sent to this División.

I have been appointed as General Inspector of the Protection and Nuclear Safety Services of the JEN with the responsibility of care of all these matters in and outside the Center. Also I am responsible for the medical care, whole body counter, uranium mines and Plant and Indalo Project (Palomares) and the Nuclear Medicine Group. I can utilize all the people I need and also all the facilities of the Center and outside.

Several others Divisións have been traslocated and we are now a little dizzy with such a great earthquake. But I hope everything will be soon ready. Newertheless our Indalo Project follows its way in variability and Emilio although is in the other Division follows with my compliance collaborating in it as a particular and personal concession of me.

I am looking forward to see you here when all the items be working. I think it will be interesting you know the Palomares area and discuss closely with us all the data we are compiling and perhaps to agree the way of to do a joint paper to be published anywhere.


