Dear Mr. McCraw:

Thank you for sending copies of documents concerning the Palomares incident. This is the first time I have seen documented the internal deposition of people involved in the cleanup. This information will help in our Public Acceptance Program.

There are still some questions that you may be able to answer:

1. What quantity of plutonium was involved? (The answer may be classified, but perhaps you can give me a "ball-park" number.)
2. What was the approximate cost of the cleanup? (Man hours or dollars or both.)
3. What follow-up is being done today to determine residual plutonium contamination, measurement of resuspension and potential health problems at Palomares?
4. Are any of the ERDA (AEC) reports available to the public? (So far, all I have seen are reports from the Spanish JEN, an Air Force report and news media reports.)
