VISIT TO SPAIN

Dave Bruner has been in touch with me about a visit he plans in July to Spain. He wants to take a Fiddler instrument with him in order to obtain some additional environmental data around Palomares. We have the Fiddler and can lend it to him. However, it seems to me that if more environmental data on plutonium distribution at Palomares is needed, the way to obtain it is with an aerial survey using the helicopter instrumentation. As John Harley says this would provide data that have not been collected before.

I suggest that we discuss this early in the week of June 23 so we can decide about recommendations for further surveys before Dave leaves about July 5.
