Re: Resettlement Trust Fund for the People of Bikini

Dear Ms. Plummer:

I am writing at the request of the Kili/Bikini/Ejit Local Government Council ("Council") to clarify and confirm the obligations and responsibilities of Security Trust Company as trustee of the Resettlement Trust Fund for the People of Bikini ("Resettlement Trust Fund") with respect to the November 20, 1989 Memorandum of Agreement Between the U.S. Department of the Interior and the U.S. Department of Energy Nevada Operations Office for the Rehabilitation and Resettlement of Bikini Atoll ("Memorandum of Agreement").

First, this letter reaffirms the statements contained in my September 18, 1989 letter to Larry Morgan, a copy of which is enclosed for your convenience. That letter spells out the method of payment and approvals required for Security Trust to wire transfer to the Interior Department those sums requested by it under the Memorandum of Agreement.

Second, I am writing to confirm that the Interior Department, pursuant to the terms of an April 9, 1991 Memorandum of Agreement Among the U.S. Department of the Interior, the Kili/Bikini/Ejit Local Government Council and Security Trust Company, N.A. for the Administration of the Resettlement Trust Fund for the People of Bikini, a copy of which is being faxed to you under separate cover, has approved expenditures totaling \$250,000 for Department of Energy support for the current fiscal year. Assuming that your office's expenditures are directly related to such support and are approved by the U.S. Department of Interior, the Resettlement Trust Fund will reimburse the Interior Department up to this amount of money for the current fiscal year.
